Provincial Assessments 2025-2026

Dear Parents & Guardians,

As part of the updated graduation requirements, students must complete **three** provincial assessments by the end of their Grade 12 year:

- Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment (NME10)
- Grade 10 Literacy Assessment (LTE10)
- Grade 12 Literacy Assessment (LTE12)*

*French Immersion students must also write Évaluation de littératie de la 12^e année (LTF12) in their grade 11 year at MSS. Please contact Mme. Warren for more information.

Notes:

- Students are automatically registered to write NME10 and LTE10 in their Grade 10 year and LTE12 in their grade 12 year at MSS
- Assessment results can be checked through the MyEducation portal about one month after writing an assessment
- Grade 11 and 12 students who have not written their grade 10 assessments must catch up before graduation
- Students can re-write any assessment up to two times, if they choose. To register for a re-write, please contact Mrs. Musgrave.

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Reporting Results and Re-writes:

Provincial graduation assessments use a four-level proficiency scale for reporting student achievement results. Literacy 12 and Numeracy 10 assessment scores will appear on students' report cards/transcripts and can be accessed through their MyEducation portal. Please note that some universities require a score of 3 ("Proficient") for admission. Please check with your post-secondary institution for more information.
